Games: Games are 20 minutes with a five-minute break between games. Breaks are typically signified by music playing. We ask that you please assist your child between games to move to the correct fields and for bathroom breaks as needed. Scarborough High School players will often be officiating games – this is a great learning opportunity for these players, and we appreciate your patience and support while they are reffing.

Fields: As noted in the schedule above, there are many fields for this event. The turf will be divided into 7 smaller fields and the grass field will be divided into 3 fields. **Please note that all games for this division will be on the grass fields.** Fields are typically marked. There are multiple parking areas around the school. Bathrooms are located by the concessions area. There will be concessions and apparel for sale.

Clothing and Equipment:

- **Equipment:** All players must have shinguards, mouth guard, and their stick. They will not be able to participate without these so please do not forget them. *Please check with your player about mouthguards. We are still seeing players arrive without them.*
- **Shirts:** Please have players wear their maroon SPR Field Hockey t-shirt.
- **Hair pulled back and NO JEWELRY!** We've had a lot of players arriving with their hair down. Please tie their hair back to avoid it hanging in their face and preventing them from seeing the field of play. Thank you!
- **Food:** please pack water and snacks for your player for breaks.

Turf Rules:

- ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED ON THE TURF. Only WATER is allowed on the turf.
- **Spectators:** Spectators are NOT allowed on the turf and must stay outside of the gated areas; only coaches and players will be allowed on the turf. Stadium seating is available for turf games. No chairs or coolers will be allowed on the turf.
- No pets allowed at the fields except for service animals.
