Tasks: Help us prepare the schools' gardens and parks for the return of students and teachers this fall! Starting at Fairfield School, we will clean-up garden beds, mulch, and remove invasive species. If we have enough volunteers in attendance, we will plant a back-to-school flower bed alongside the C.K. Burns School sign. At both sites, volunteers will complete a general once-over of the grounds to make sure they are clean and safe for play.

Equipment: Please wear sturdy shoes, work clothes, and work gloves if you have them. Please bring a water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray and anything else you need to be comfortable working outside.

Tools - please bring any of the following items you may have: Shovels, Wheelbarrows, Gloves, Trash bags, Hand pruners, Rakes, 2–5 gallon buckets. Saco Parks and Recreation will also have some tools available.

Weather: We plan to work rain or shine.
