T-ball Season Announcements and Info: sent April 6, 2022



Dear parents and guardians:

Spring is here (or arriving soon?) and SPR T-ball starts during the week of April 25th! Here are a couple of important notes regarding teams, schedules, locations, and the start of the season for all divisions:

Rosters: Rosters for Beginner and Intermediate division teams are now posted online under <u>Team Information</u> at <u>sacorec.com</u>. We appreciate your understanding that we may not be able to accommodate any changes now that teams are established.

Online schedule:

Start Smart divisions practice on Saturdays*. Practice times depend on the time you signed up for; players may only attend their scheduled session. Please email SPR Programmer Meg Gribbin at mgribbin@sacomaine.org if you are unsure.

*Please note that our Start Smart divisions will have their first session on Saturday, April 30th. This is also Picture Day.

Beginner and Intermediate T-ball schedules include weekday practices, and games. Practices start the week of April 25th prior to Picture Day. Practices will take place at the Saco Community Center on the field adjacent to the playground or at the North Street practice field located at Young School – locations are noted on team schedules. Games start May 7th at Memorial Field located behind C.K. Burns.

Equipment: all players will need to bring a glove for this program – make sure this is labeled with your child's name. SPR will provide all other necessary equipment, and we ask that players please leave bats at home. Shirts and hats are provided on Picture Day, and please have players wear these to each game. We recommend players dress appropriately for the weather and ready to play. Players should wear comfortable, close-toed shoes. Sneakers are fine, and cleats are optional.

Volunteers: We appreciate those who have already volunteered to assist us and we welcome all the help we can get from parents during practices and games in all divisions. Parent participation is required for Start Smart divisions. Thanks in advance for your help!

Spectators: We ask that families stay for practices and games to support their children. Please be mindful of overcrowding the fields, especially during practices with combined teams, and be sure to allow staff and players plenty of room while they participate.

Save the Date - Picture Day: Picture Day is Saturday, April 30th at the Saco Community Center inside the gymnasium. All divisions will participate. Schedules for the day have been posted to Team Info. We will send an additional email with event details and specific photo ordering info in the next couple of weeks.
