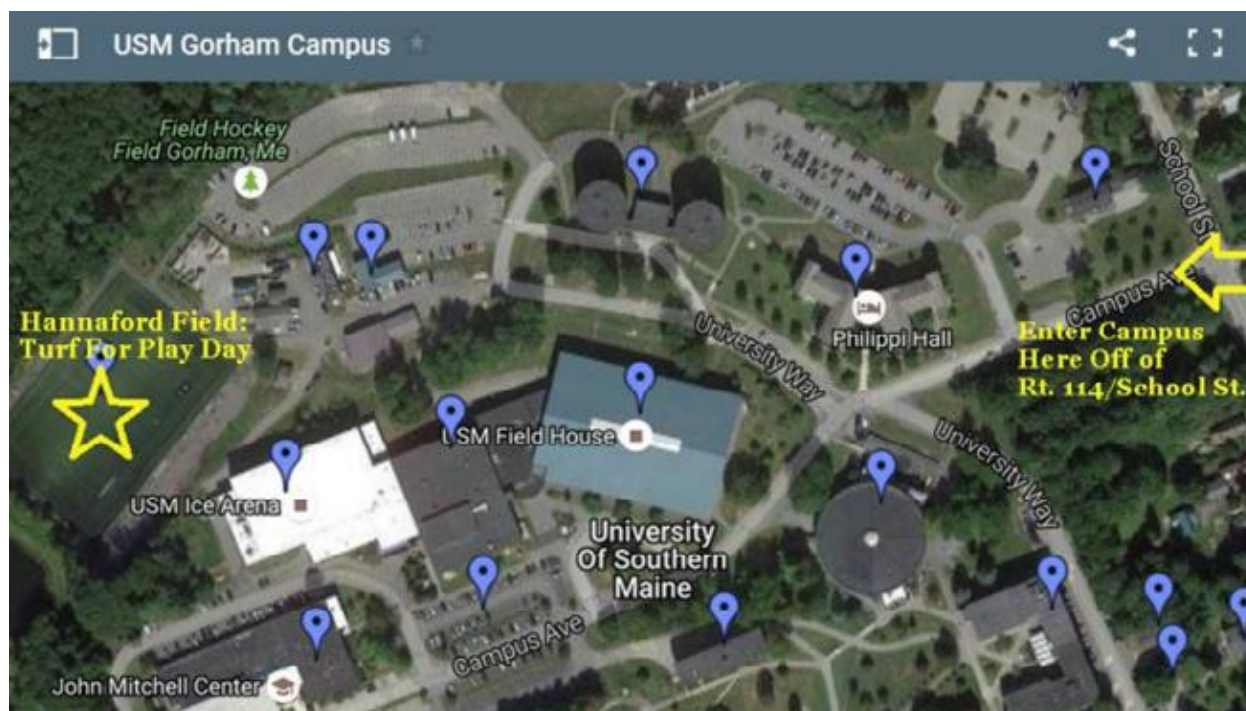


USM Youth Field Hockey Playday Info: Sunday, September 14th 2025

Where: USM Campus— 37 College Ave, Gorham, ME

Field: Hannaford Field. The field will be divided into several smaller fields. Please see the campus map below.



Paid Parking: Please give yourself time to park on campus. The event organizers have shared the information below regarding required paid parking. (\$1.05/hour – Standard Vehicle)

To Pay upon Arrival using a Mobile Device:

- Scan the QR code located in your parking lot or at the entrance to the venue.
- Enter your mobile number
- Enter your license plate #
- Select the amount of time you plan to remain in the lot
- (1 hour, 2 hours, 3 hours, 4 hours, 5 hours, or Day Rate = entire day through to 11 pm)
- Enter payment information, hit start parking

Parking will be very limited near the field so dropping off players and then parking may be the best option. Carpooling is recommended if possible.

Games: Games are 25 minutes with a five-minute break in between. Games will be 7v7 so players will have adequate rest throughout the day. We ask families to please assist your child between games for bathroom breaks as needed while coaches organize players and transition between fields.

USM Field Hockey college players will be officiating and organizing games. Please keep in mind these are players, not officials, and will do their best. This is a great learning opportunity for these players and we appreciate your patience and support while they are reffing.

Clothing and Equipment:

- **Equipment:** All players must have shinguards, mouth guard, and their stick. They will not be able to participate without these so please do not forget them.
- **Shirts:** Please have all players wear their maroon SPR Field Hockey t-shirt.
- **Hair pulled back and NO JEWELRY!** Please have players arrive with no jewelry and their earrings already taken out at home. If your child cannot remove their earrings due to recent ear piercings, please make sure their earrings are covered with medical tape or band-aids before they arrive at the fields. This is for the safety of the player to prevent earrings from being snagged on clothing/hair or hit.
- **Hydration:** please pack lots of water for your player for breaks. We will be playing a lot of field hockey in a short period of time!

Turf Rules:

- ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED ON THE TURF. Only WATER is allowed on the turf.
- **Spectator seating:** Please sit on the side of the fields off the turf. It is recommended to bring chairs or blankets to sit on.

Concessions: There will be concessions, 50/50 raffle, and field hockey clothing items available for sale for those that are interested.
